



“I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”


Outward Peace

Write them on the doorframes of your house and on your gates, so that your days and the days of your children may be as many as the days that the heavens are above the earth.


Inward Peace

that cannot be taken away from you.**


Inward Peace

Matthew 28:18-20

“Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”
